Monthly Summary for the month of April, 2018

Important events for the month of April, 2018 are as follows:

1. During the month, Brahmaputra Cracker & Polymer Limited (BCPL) has produced 21,745 MT of Polymers and 5,268 MT of Liquid Hydrocarbons. 21,890 MT of Polymers and 4,561 MT of Liquid Hydrocarbons have been sold during the month.
2. During the month of April, 2018, 13,849 students were undergoing long term training programmes i.e. UG/PG/Diploma/PG Diploma etc., and 376 students completed their skill training through short term training programmes at different centres of Central Institute of Plastics Engineering and Technology under its Skill Development activities.
3. Secretary (C&PC) undertook a comprehensive review of the annual performance of the 32 functional Centres of CIPET (for 2017-18) on 13th-14th April, 2018. Performance against annual targets agreed to between the Department and CIPET as part of the MoU for the year that include skilling, technology support to industry, academics and research & development were discussed and targets for 2018-19 were assigned to each of the centres. In addition, functional improvements and implementation of Swachh Bharat, Digital India, Make in India activities with reference to CIPET were also reviewed.
4. In the month of April, 2018, 15 grievances were brought forward and 39 grievances were received, of which 32 have been disposed. Of the remaining 22 grievances, only 01 grievance is of more than 90 days pendency.
