

Minutes of the meeting of Departmental Committee held on 08.09.2025 and 03.11.2025 to adjudge the suitability of the candidates for compassionate appointment in Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals.

With the primary objective of providing immediate assistance to relief the dependent family of a government servant who dies in harness thereby leaving his family in financial destitution i.e. penurious condition, Government of India has made a scheme of Compassionate Appointment in dealing with such cases. The financial resources available to the dependents and the financial deprivation caused to the dependents as a result of death of the Government servant are need to be considered while making compassionate appointment.

2. As per laid down provisions of DoP&T, a maximum of 5% of the vacancies under Direct Recruitment quota can be filled by compassionate appointment. In the Department, 20 vacancies were occurred on 15.07.2024 in Group C and MTS grade. Accordingly, 5% of 20 vacancies i.e. one vacancy in Group C was considered for the compassionate appointment.

3. In view of the above, a Departmental Committee, comprising of following officers, was constituted for considering the applications received for the appointment to the one post of MTS on compassionate grounds and to make recommendations:

- (i) Shri Ganesh Singh, Deputy Secretary, D/o C&PC
- (ii) Shri Shibu Das, US (Admin), D/o C&PC
- (iii) Smt Manju Singh, US (Coord.), D/o C&PC

4. In this regard, the following candidates have been requested to provide the requisite information for the compassionate appointment for the post MTS in DCPC:

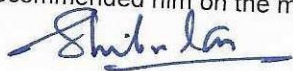

5. In this context, only 3 candidates (appearing at S. No. 3, 4 and 5) have submitted the required documents. However, Smt. Biro, wife of late Sh. Tukki Ram, did not submit any documents/information despite reminder. The correspondence including reminder issued to Sh. Sandeep Kumar, son of late Sh. Ved Singh, SO, was returned with the remark 'No such person at the address. Further, Sh. Sandeep Kumar did not respond to mobile calls made by Estt Division.

6. In this regard, a preliminary meeting of the above mentioned Committee was held on 08.09.2025 to scrutinize the applications of candidates and gave certain suggestions with reference to maximum marks fixed for various parameters taken into account for assessment of the candidates for the stated purpose.

7. Thereafter, the Committee in its meeting held on 03.11.2025, considered the cases of the above stated three candidates on various parameters, as per details given in the annexures, including the financial condition to assess their suitability.

8. The Committee is of the opinion that Shri Vishal, son of late Shri Bishan Chand, MTS, deserves to be considered for appointment to the post of MTS on compassionate grounds and accordingly recommended him on the matter.
